Given that the purpose of the OZ is investment in targeted areas, anyone can take advantage of the impact these zones could bring to the area.

As such, this report is not restricted to only the owners of the OZ funds. Among the many potential users of this include, but not limited to:

investors | developers | residents | community organizers | church officials/patrons | politicians | businesses | contractors | educators | school board members | reporters

These are a few of the individuals who may find this report. As you can see that the mentioned groups cross various industries and professions. There are endless groups who can use this report to find out where the OZs are and how to take advantage of these zones.

The overall goal is to provide you with information on the where the OZ is located within a region, state, county, and tract. With this report, you can use this report for informational purposes in making better informed decisions as well as strategize on how you can benefit from the OZs.

Here are some steps on how to use this report in searching for desired OZs.

- 1. This report will help you locate the OZ of interest using the following steps.
 - a. Determine the region(s).
 - b. Determine the state(s).
 - c. Determine the county or counties.
 - d. This report has a section for each State for easily researching. Within each State section, you will find the following:
 - Quick facts related to the OZs within the State.
 - Listing of State and County codes of that State.
 - Listing of that State's counties with the number of OZs for each county.

- Listing of State's counties with a designated OZ census tract number and tract information as to whether it is a Low-Income Community (LIC) or Non-Low-Income Contiguous (Non-LIC Contiguous) area.
- 2. Have a reliable internet connection so that you can access the OZ map located at <u>U.S. Treasury CDFI Fund OZ</u>

 Map to find the OZ by the census tract code.
 - a. The next section of this report will discuss how to read an OZ census tract code.
 - b. Within the OZ map, make sure that you select the following options to better view the OZs
 - Qualified Opportunity Zone Tract key option to select to help search for OZ using the designated census tracts.
 - County (*No Labels*) optional if you are looking to better see what county that the designated OZ is located within a State.
 - Congressional District (No Labels) optional if you are looking for PR spin to help OZ fund and area
 of interest.
 - State key option to select to help search for OZ using the designated census tracts.
- 3. Using the OZ map and this report, you can see what the OZ looks through one of the following viewing options:
 - Satellite (preferred)
 - Street
 - Gray canvas

These steps will provide you with the basic guidance in how to search for OZs using this report and the OZ map. Further, you can have a better viewpoint to make better informed decisions in determining whether the OZ is a vital opportunity.


How to Read an Opportunity Zone Census Tract Code

More than 8,700 designated Opportunity Zones (OZ) are assigned an eleven-digit census tract code. In the Northeast Region of the United States, there are 1,302 OZs. All OZ census tract codes will read like the following:

09001020100

This code is important in determining where you can operate your OZ fund. Specifically, this code will tell the state, county and tract within the county where the OZ is located. However, it is important to know what these census tract codes mean so that you can research and make relevant information on whether to invest in the OZ.

So, let us break down what these OZ census tract codes mean in plain language. Taking the above-mentioned OZ census tract codes as an example Listed below is an example of an OZ along with an explanation of what in set of number mean.



The first two digits of the tract code represent the State or territory. Each State will have a unique two-digit code. For the example, "09" or first two digits indicates that the OZ is located in the state of Connecticut.

The next three digits of the tract code represent the county within the State. Each county will have a unique three-digit code. For the above example, "001" indicates that the OZ is located in Fairfield County of the state of Connecticut.

The final six digits of the tract code represent the tract within the county of the State. Each tract will have a unique number to identify the OZ. For the above example, "09001" indicates that the OZ is located within a designated tract or

area within Fairfield County of the state of Connecticut. The tract code could include, but not limited to street block(s), major landmass(es) that have vacant or existing building(s).

NOTE: Some of the OZs may include vacant deserts, mountainous areas, existing structure. Ensure that you research the OZs before investing. Also, each of the OZ tracts will be designated as either a Low-Income Community (LIC) or Non-Low-Income Contiguous (Non-LIC Contiguous) area where the OZ is located.

Overall, you would read the tract as follows: The OZ has a tract located within Fairfield County of the state of Connecticut.

See the next section on page 5 for the OZ Code Legend that will show you the two-digit codes assigned to states.

Now you know what the OZ codes mean and can better search for information regarding the desired OZ.
