- What is your organization's policies and procedures on using AI?
- What is your audit division's policies and procedures on using AI?
- Will the use of AI be an in-house application or the use of outsource application?
- Which AI application will you use to meet your engagement objective?
- Who controls the information within the AI application?
- What information will you need to provide to the AI to meet your engagement objective?
- Will the information contain any PII, BII, or other sensitive information?
- How will you handle PII, BII, or other sensitive information within the AI application?
- How will you store the information used in within the AI application?
- How will you protect the information used within the AI application with unauthorized access?
- What controls will you have in place to fact check any results generated from the AI or minimize AI hallucination?
- How will you document the use of AI?

Keep in mind that these questions are not all inclusive, but get you thinking about Al and its use with your audit engagement work.
